DAY 03 [B/-/-] SARAJEVO - MOSTAR - MEDJUGORJE



Admire the architectural beauty of the Koski Mehmed Pasha Mosque and take in the panoramic views from its minaret. We will also learn about the town's rich history at the Museum of Herzegovina. Continuing our journey, we will arrive in the small Herzegovinian town of Medjugorje, one of the most popular pilgrimage destinations in Europe today, attracting more than one million pilgrims annually. Since June 24, 1981, there have been six Apparitions of the Virgin Mary, making this town a significant spiritual site. Medjugorje is situated in the Herzegovina region of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina, and its name literally means "between the mountains." Upon arrival, we will visit Apparition Hill, where the Virgin Mary first appeared to the local children. Next, we will explore the Shrine of Our Lady of Medjugorje, which houses the statue of the Peace Queen. We will also see the statue of Jesus and visit Saint James Church, a central place of worship and community gathering. The serene and spiritual atmosphere of Medjugorje offers a unique and profound experience for all visitors. After our visits, we will settle into our accommodation, reflecting on the spiritual significance of the day. For those interested in exploring further, consider the optional tour to Kravice Waterfall, a breathtaking natural wonder located on the Trebizat River. This majestic waterfall, 25 meters high with a lake radius of 120 meters at its base, offers a refreshing escape and is a perfect spot for picnics and swimming.

DAY 04 [B/-/-] MEDJUGORJE

DAY 06 [B/-/-] SHKODER - TİRANA - OHRİD



As we arrive, we will explore the charming late medieval bazaar, a bustling area filled with shops, cafes, and historic buildings. Here, we will find both a church and a mosque standing close by, reflecting the city's diverse cultural heritage. We will also visit the reconstructed fortress, which offers panoramic views of the city and provides a glimpse into Skopje's storied past. The iconic Stone Bridge, an enduring symbol of the city, connects the old and new parts of Skopje and is a testament to the city's enduring resilience. A visit to the Memorial House of Mother Teresa, who was born in Skopje, will offer a poignant moment of reflection. This memorial honors the life and legacy of the Nobel Peace Prize laureate and provides insight into her early years and humanitarian work. Just east of Skopje, this breathtaking canyon spans 5,000 hectares and features lush vegetation, medieval monasteries, and the historic Matka Lake, the oldest artificial lake in North Macedonia. It's a perfect escape for nature lovers and history enthusiasts alike.



DAY 08 [B/-/-] SKOPJE



After visiting the Blue Mosque, head to Hagia Sophia for photostop, located just a short walk away. Learn about the fascinating history and significance of Hagia Sophia from your knowledgeable Honest Travel guide. After Hagia Sophia, make your way to outside photostop at Topkapi Palace. Topkapi Palace, located in the historic district of Istanbul, Turkey, is an architectural marvel that served as the primary residence and administrative headquarters of the Ottoman sultans for nearly 400 years. Its exterior is as impressive as its interior, showcasing a blend of architectural styles that reflect the grandeur and opulence of the Ottoman Empire. Also we can make combination visit with Topkapi Palace, Hagia Sofia entrances + Grand Bazar visit + lunch (optional) Before you leave the old city area visit Spice Market for shopping. The Spice Market, also known as the Egyptian Bazaar (Misir Çarşısı in Turkish), is one of Istanbul's oldest and most famous covered markets, renowned for its vibrant atmosphere, exotic aromas, and colorful array of spices, herbs, and traditional Turkish delicacies. Then, we will have Bosphorus Tour (optional) to discover one of the most beautiful view of world. After this exploration, transfer to hotel for rest and accommodation.

DAY 12 [B/-/-] ISTANBUL DEPARTURE

After breakfast at hotel, we will depart to Taksim Square and İstiklal Street for free time. Taksim Square and İstiklal Street are two of Istanbul's most vibrant and iconic landmarks, known for their bustling atmosphere, rich history, and cultural significance. Later on we will drive to the Airport (IST) while saying goodbye to city and back to home with unforgettable memories.
